FESTIVAL CHECKLIST

Before you even leave the house, make sure you have:

1. Your tickets for the shows, if you purchased them in advance. Although we can reprint them for you, remembering to bring them will save you time and stress.
2. Remember to bring your wallet (with ID, driver's license, insurance cards, debit cards, spending money), camera, cell phone, phone/car charger, luggage, lawn chairs (to sit out at our street stage), hotel confirmation, sunscreen, sunglasses, hat/cap, car/hotel snacks, bottled water (perhaps a small cooler or cooler bag) and a pen or marker (for autographs).
3. Have everyone in your group's cell number written down on a piece of paper in your wallet. If you don't and you need to reach them...you can't. You've got no one to call.
4. Extra batteries if your camera requires them and the AC/DC power cords for your electronic devices, if you're bringing a laptop or tablet.

Arriving at the Festival in downtown Collingwood:

1. Write down where you parked! You swear that you will remember but in all the Festival fun and excitement, you may not.
2. Make sure you have not left your keys in the car before locking it. It is always handy to have an extra set with you as well...just in case!
3. Make sure you carry only basic essentials with you so you do not lose or forget items in the crowded areas that may be valuable to you because chances are good that you won't get them back.
4. Once inside the festival area, everybody agree on a designated location so that if you get separated, you can meet up there at a designated time.

5. Visit the Festival Information Booth to pick up a free copy of the Weekend Event Guide so you will know where everything is going on and when!
6. If you haven't gotten your tickets yet, head to the Box Office located behind the Business Development Centre (just follow the signs) and get what you need.
7. Visit our Festival Merchandise Booth to be first to get the best picks of the 2017 merchandise and to purchase your copy of our Souvenir Program (just \$5.00) to get your favourite Elvis Tribute Artists to autograph.

Other miscellaneous "handy stuff":

1. Wet wipes, toilet paper or kleenex. Wet wipes are good for anything from porta-potty business to cleaning your hands before/after eating.
2. Gum, mints, light snacks, folding toothbrush/travel-sized toothpaste and deodorant.
3. Prepare for inclement weather so bring a rain poncho just in case!
4. Hand sanitizer. There is not enough hand sanitizer in the world at a music festival. Trust us.
