Collingwood, Ontario – The 19th Annual Collingwood Elvis Festival is the largest Preliminary Elvis Tribute Contest, with more than 100 professional and non-professional Elvis Tribute Artists competing from all around the globe throughout the four days – July 25 to July 28.

Competition categories are specific to all the eras of Elvis' career, from the 50's to the final years in the 70's. The competition culminates with the Grand Finals event, where the best of the best goes on to compete in Memphis, Tennessee, in August during Elvis Week, representing the Collingwood Elvis Festival in the Ultimate Elvis Tribute Artist Contest, presented by Elvis Presley Enterprises.

The Grand Champion competition starts on Friday night with qualifying rounds and continues with the semi-finals and grand finals at the Eddie Bush Arena, in the heart of historic Downtown Collingwood.
